EASTERN DISTRICT CROSS-COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIP.

The annual Eastern District Cross-Country Championship race for the Fraser Trophy took place at Hawick on Saturday. Thirteen teams competed from Edinburgh, Fife, Dundee, and the Borders, and there was also one individual entry. The teams consisted of twelve runners each, and they assembled in the Common Haugh, and were dispatched on the race by Provost Nichol. The route extended to about seven miles or so, round by the back of Wilton Lodge to Wilton Dean, Howlets Plantation, Overhall, Borthaugh, Martinshouse, Langheugh, and the New Road to the starting point, and thence over the same route again.
