MARIE DUTHIE was a comfortable winner of the Eastern District women's cross-country championships at Aberdeen, *Fraser Clyne reports.*

The Fraserburgh athlete, who has emerged as one of Scotland's leading road runners in recent months, adapted well to the windy, wet and muddy conditions. Leading from the gun she steadily pulled away from her challengers over the parkland course and eventually finished 125 yards ahead of international triathlete Ginny Pollard.

The reigning champion, Sheila Gollan, a policewomen from Inverness, took the bronze medal, ahead of the leading veteran Aileen Wilson (Dundee Hawkhill Harriers) with Sally Ann Hales finishing fifth. Hales, who is still Britain's third fastest marathon runner of all-time on account of her 2:28:38 third place at London in 1985, is now based in Dundee following a move from Oxford.

With Karen Powell 11th Dundee Hawkhill just pipped the host club for the team title.

Dundee's successful day continued when Yvonne Reilly won the Intermediates three mile race. Isabel Linaker (Pitreavie) was an equally impressive winner of the junior title while her clubmate Jennifer Ward was a clear winner of the girls race.

Debbie Murray (Lasswade) caused an upset in the under-11's championship by inflicting a rare defeat upon Aberdeen's Hannah Smith.
