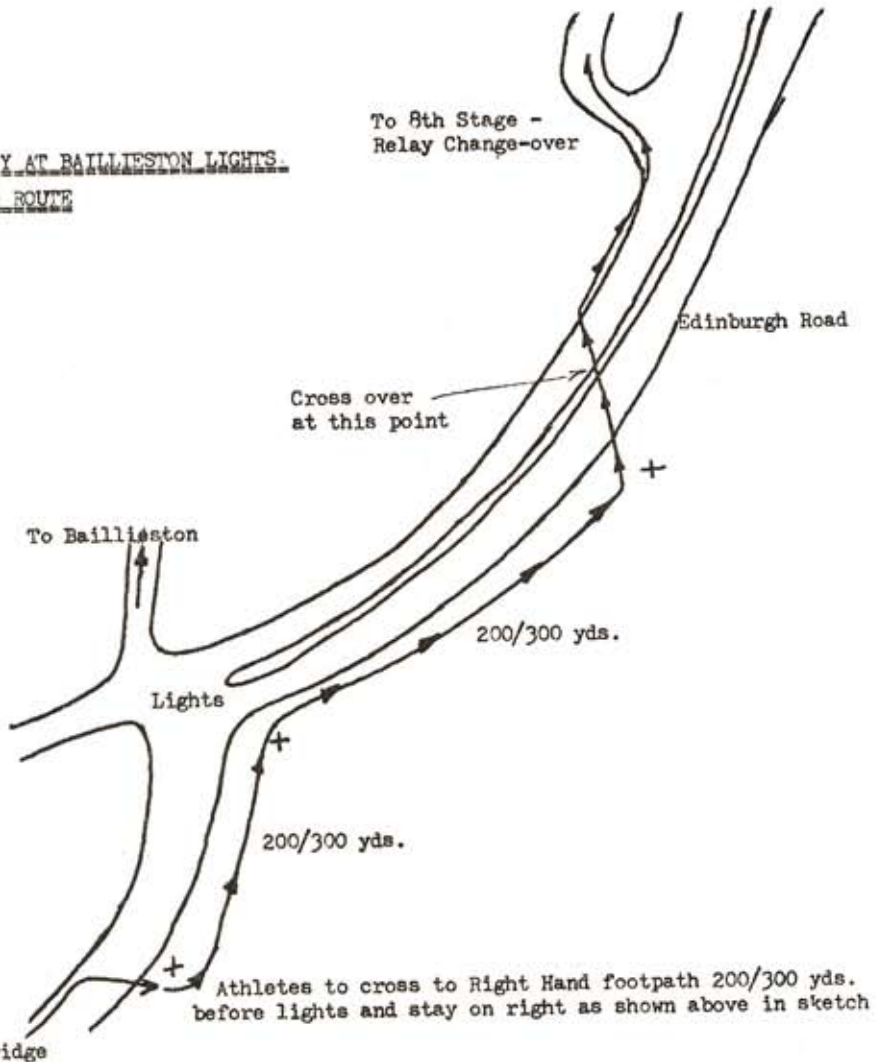

EDINBURGH TO GLASGOW RELAY RACE

R U L E S:

1. The race will be run under the Rules and Laws of the Scottish Cross Country Union.
2. Team entries shall be governed by the first claim rule. See Rule 9 (Page 6 S.C.C.U. Handbook). Rule 8 (Page 60) will also apply to stage six.
3. Competitors must wear letter numbers back and front corresponding to the numbers allotted to them in the programme and their official club vest.
4. All teams will carry a baton throughout the race (i.e. in the hand).
5. Any team falling 30 minutes behind the leading team may be taken out of the race.
6. All competitors must keep to the left-hand side of the road (3 yards from kerb maximum allowance) throughout the course. Any competitor attempting to leave this course to cut corners or cross to the right-hand side of the road for any purpose will render his team liable to disqualification.
7. Pacing of runners by private car or bus or in any other way is strictly forbidden.
8. Competitors may travel in the official coaches.
9. All competitors except those running in the first relay must be in their respective coaches ready to start at 11.00 a.m. No competitor will be waited for. Only competitors and officials will be allowed to travel in the coaches.
10. To avoid congestion, no coach may stop within 880 yards of the first take over and within 200 yards of each of the other take-overs.
11. The teams to be invited will be selected by the Scottish Cross Country Union.
12. Failure to observe the foregoing Rules may render the offending Club liable to disqualification.

B Y E - L A W S:

1. Persons following the race by private car or bus :
 - (a) Must not park within 880 yards of the first take over.
 - (b) Must not park within 200 yards of any of the other take overs.
 - (c) Must not travel in front, alongside or behind any of the runners at or near to the same speed as the runner.
 - (d) Must not in any way obstruct the free movement of traffic on the roads.
 - (e) Must not park on a "clearway".
2. Any person or persons violating the above Rules may render his or their Club ineligible to compete in the following year's race and may render that Club liable to disqualification.
3. The Clerks of the Course will make enquiries into all reported instances of the violation of these Rules and ascertain which Club the offending spectators are members of. That Club will immediately be warned as to the future conduct of their supporters and as to the names of the offending supporters. It will then be the duty of that Club to take action against the offenders.
4. The Clerks of the Course will report to General Committee full details of all instances of warning Clubs as to the conduct of their supporters. The General Committee will decide whether or not it is advisable to invite these Clubs to compete in the following year's race.
