Minutes of Meeting of Wednesday 20th February 2013 held at 6.30 p.m.

1. Chairman's Welcome and Opening Remarks

- 1.1 Ron welcomed everyone to the meeting. The Commission noted with sadness the recent deaths of Jim Semple of Shettleston Harriers and Martin Craven of Edinburgh Southern Harriers.
- 1.2 Ron confirmed that the meeting would continue the practice of only discussing those agenda items which had been starred and invited any additional items to be starred that had been identified by Commission members.
- 1.3 Copies of the minutes of the recent West District Road Running and Cross Country Commission were circulated. Margaret reported on recent changes to officials for the West District and requested advice on representation at the Commission. As Clare Barr will now attend the meeting in her capacity as Convenor of the West District RR&CC Commission, another representative of the West District is required. 3.3 Actions Outstanding:

4. Fixtures/Championships

- 4.1 National Cross Country Championships, Falkirk, 23/2/13: Alex reported that 1955 entries had been received for this event. Entries from young athletes had increased although senior entries were slightly reduced. Chip timing would be introduced as a pilot with a manual recording system operating as a back-up. Arrangements for marshalling and athletes' numbers were discussed and noted. The Commission discussed the success of this event having taken place at Falkirk for some years now and noted the merits of this. Alternative venues were also discussed and it was agreed this item would be put on the agenda of the strategy meeting due to be held in August. **Action: RRCC2013-3: AJ**

5. Performance and Participation Targets

- 5.1 Suggestions and proposals for performance and participation targets had been put forward by a number of the Commission members. These were discussed in turn. The challenges of ensuring targets were within the scope of influence and control of the Commission was noted as a key issue. It was noted that some proposals were already included within reporting arrangements to funding bodies.

- 5.2 Arising from the discussion, it was agreed that some information and approaches may benefit the ability to further develop performance and participation targets. These included:

- a) an analysis of the age group profiles of athletes at Senior and above level for road and cross country championships. This would help identify participation levels at the transition from junior to senior; senior and the range of masters' age groups.
- b) Requiring masters' athletes to wear a 'V' or should this be 'M' on their back would assist athletes competing in team races to have a better understanding of where they are.

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- c) A method of appointing officials at the start of the season similar to that adopted within the track and field season.
- d) A mechanism for tracking the transition of recreational runners into athletics clubs, i.e. from Jog Scotland networks.

- 5.3 Following extensive discussion, it was agreed that Ron would develop a paper for further consideration at the next Commission meeting. Included within this as key things that define what we want to measure and that would tell us what is going on, would be:
- a) Participation levels (number of athletes in national championships; seniors in age categories; clubs participation in road relays/national relays at senior level
 - b) Quality (i.e. record number of athletes into World/European/UK teams; medals; athletes finishing in the top 50 at the Inter Counties and appearing in the Power of 10 for road races)
