4.3 Alex reported on entries for the upcoming Trail Championships of 96 men and 54 women.

- 4.4 Following discussion on the calendar of events prepared by Mark and in particular on whether District road championships should be included in this, it was agreed that the creation of a fuller championship document which would enable District secretaries to be aware of and notify athletes about key championship venues and dates would be useful. - 5.1 It was noted that the results and standings in Grand Prix events weren't as visible as might be hoped due to the need to keep the front 'news' page fresh on the website. It was agreed it would be helpful for this to be discussed with Peter Jardine. **Action: RRCC2013-7: TF/MP**

6. Performance and Participation Targets

- 6.1 The Commission considered a table, previously circulated, which tracked performance levels for both male and female athletes at endurance events (including track) from 2006 to 2012. The table indicated a decline in numbers year on year in track events in particular and it was felt this may be related to the reduced number of track opportunities for athletes at 10,000 metres. It was agreed the table would be updated annually and included in the online archive. **Action: RRCC2013-8: RM/MJ/MP**

- 6.2 The Board of Scottish Athletics had recommended the adoption of trail running as a discipline. It was noted that in trail running, athletes were recognised as Masters from age 40.
