

DISTRICT RELAYS

Harrier Team Times In Ten-Mile Races

SHETTLESTON HARRIERS led throughout to win the ten miles Midland relay championship at Hamilton, beating a grand young Maryhill team by 60 yards in 56 mins. 2 secs., with Plebeian, the holders, over 100 yards behind Maryhill.

J. C. Flockhart, the national champion, gave the winners a 30 yards advantage in the first circuit of the racecourse, but T. Lamb, the novice champion of Bellahouston, chased him hard. R. S. Hill lost much of Shettleston's lead in the next lap, but W. Sutherland and J. C. Ross made sure of victory during the second half of the journey.

M'Laren, Wellpark, gained five places for his club to lead the field at the end of the next circuit, with J. Burns, Glenpark, close behind. Over the penultimate lap D. Turner, Glenpark, raised the hopes of the holders by handing over a fifty yards lead to R. Holmes, but M. Barr, Beith, showed excellent judgment in overtaking and beating his Greenock rival.
