

SCOTTISH CHAMPIONSHIP.

The Western District Championship of the Scottish National Cross-country Union was decided at Thornbank, near Glasgow, on Saturday. There was a capital entry, much the same in numbers as last year, but a notable absentee was Duncan McPhee, West of Scotland H., the Scottish half-mile and mile flat champion. A course of about 7 miles was laid out, and although the going was heavy, fairly good time was recorded. First and second men home were provided by the representatives of the West of Scotland H., the order at the finish being: Chas Freshwater, West of Scotland H., 1; R B McIntyre, West of Scotland H., 2; Jas Mitchell, Manxline H., 3; R Miller, Manxline H., 4; D McLean, Greenock Wellpark H., 5; M E Anderson, Shettleston H., 6; M Campbell, Belshouston H., 7; J W Stanley, Shettleston H., 8. Won by fifty yards. Winner's time, 43min 42.5sec.

SCOTTISH WESTERN DISTRICT.

For the Scottish Western District Championship at Thornfield, Glasgow, over a seven mile course, there were 24 teams of nine each. The winner is a young lad of 18, and this is his first season.
