

WESTERN DISTRICT TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP.—The annual Western District junior team and individual championship of the National Cross-Country Union of Scotland was decided on Saturday afternoon, the starting and finishing points being Speirs Bridge, Thornliebank, Glasgow. There was an entry of 23 teams, and all had the necessary complements for counting, six being the minimum and nine the maximum. The trail, which was one of seven miles, provided a fine test for the runners, and lay by way of Darnley Main Farm, Darnley Shooting Range, then across Brock Burn. Here open country was taken to Balgray Reservoir and Pollok Castle, and, reaching the Stewarton road at Patterson Station, the final stretch of fully a mile was downhill to the finishing post. Results:—Individual Championship—1, R. Millar, Mauchline Harriers; 2, James Mitchell, Mauchline Harriers; 3, P. Nicol, Kilmarnock Harriers. Winner's time, 37 min., 49 sec. Team Championship—1, Greenock Wellpark Harriers (310 points); 2, Bellshouston Harriers (248 points); 3, Garscube Harriers (274 points); 4, Mauchline Harriers (275 points); 5, West of Scotland Harriers (287 points.)
