Hugh Mitchell took time off from his coaching activities to finish a good second and third man Moir Logie, fresh to the veteran ranks, led East Kilbride to second place in the team event.

Andy Forbes, Commonwealth Games 6 miles silver medallist in 1950, won the over-fifty title and J. E. Farrell, an internationalist when already in his forties, added the Scottish over-sixties title to the English title won 14 days earlier, despite a muscle injury sustained in the first rush at the gun! The 53 finishers from 57 starters included Roddy Devon, 65 in June—and he wasn't last!

The exploits of the Scottish Vets are impinging on Press and TV, and it is not only the well-known names who are bringing publicity to the sport. Enthusiasts such as John Hanton, of Paisley, who ran his first-ever race at 51—a 25 kilometre road event (!)—have caught the mood of the times for middle-aged fitness, and have been featured in the Press.
