NOVICE CHAMPIONSHIP.

BYE-LAWS.

1. Hon Secretaries of Clubs must declare names of runners comprising team along with the official number actually worn by each member of team to the Clerk of Course half-an-hour before the advertised time of start of race.
2. A bell will be rung ten minutes before the start of all Championship races.
3. All competitors must turn out on hearing the second bell, after which time the door of the stripping quarters will be closed, and any competitor not forward for the official start will be debarred from competing.
4. All competitors must have their numbers securely fixed on the front of their vest.
5. With the exception of the Club Secretary and one trainer per Club, none but competitors shall be allowed within the dressing rooms.
6. At the start of the race, competitors shall be lined up by Clubs, in the order as shown in the programme, and shall take up position from the inside of the course.
7. At the finish of a race, competitors when necessary, shall be formed by the Stewards into a single line, and each competitor must maintain his position in line until past the winning post.
8. In Championship Races no runner will be allowed to run over the course.

PROGRAMME.

Notice to Competitors.

No attendant shall accompany any competitor on the scratch mark or in the race, nor shall any competitor be allowed to receive assistance or refreshments from any one during the progress of the race. The committee shall have full power to deal with any infringement of this rule.
