MISS GREIG EASY WIN SENIOR RA

In the Scottish Women's Cross-Country Championship at Musselburgh Racecourse, Miss D. Greig (Teviotdale Harriers) regained the title, beating Miss G. Brown (Western A.C.), the favorite, by 300 yards in 20mins 30secs.

Miss M. Crawford (Harriers) was third in the 80 yards behind Miss Brown. Maryhill Harriers (Miss Ford 3, Miss L. Watson 4, Lawwood 7) retained the title with an aggregate of 14 points, fewer than Rankie Park.

In the intermediate race, Brown (Fauldhouse) finished yards ahead of Miss M. (Bellshouston) in 12mins. Miss E. Devlin (Rankie Park) third, Western A.C. (Hamilton) 4, Miss N. Caid, Miss L. Dorey (5) won the event with an aggregate of points.

Miss L. Carruthers (Harriers) had a narrow victory over Pettie (Teviotdale Harriers) in the junior contest, only one separating the runners. Green (Teviotdale) finished third in 10mins. 15secs. behind the winner, Pettie (Miss Pettie 2, Miss Caid 3, and Miss A. Wilson 5) in 10mins 15secs.
