Melbourne, Friday.

Australia made 312 runs to-day for the loss of only three wickets and laid a fine foundation in the fifth and deciding Test Match with England.

Bradman, playing sound, accurate cricket for 165 not out, equalled Jack Hobbs's record of twelve centuries in Anglo-Australian Tests. McCabe in contrast had a chancy innings, but it was worth 112 runs to Australia.

The English bowlers could do little in the fierce heat, though seven of them were tried in short spells.
