

Clyde Valley Lose Out Again

Hutton Sweeps ESH to Victory on Anchor Leg

THE SUCCESS of the inaugural Scottish National 6-Stage Road Relay Championship, held around the scenic Strathclyde Loch last year, ensured that this year's championship event would be held at the same venue as a climax to the Scottish cross-country season. The race was almost exactly a re-run of last year's with Clyde Valley, having led from half distance, and starting the final lap with a lead of 46 sec (as against 26 sec last year), being passed with just one mile to go by a brilliant run by Allister Hutton, who recorded the fastest lap of the day (26:10) to carry Edinburgh Southern to a repeat victory, and leaving Clyde Valley to accept the consolation of another set of runners-up medals. Falkirk Victoria and Spango Valley showed great improvement to finish 3rd and 4th as against 8th and 9th last year, while Shettleston (3rd in 1979) could not raise a team to compete.

Stage 1: In cold, windy conditions Douglas Frame (Law) set out on his own with the others letting him go, preferring the shelter of a pack.

He was never caught and came home 25 sec inside the existing course record with Martin Craven (ESH) leading the bunch 39 sec behind. Paul Forbes (EAC, 18:48) showed good form and looks to have a good track season in front of him, possibly over the steeplechase. **Fastest:** Frame 18:04; Craven 18:43; J. Small (CV) 18:46.

Stage 2: Edinburgh Southern went into a 31 sec lead as Clyde Valley dropped to 9th. Frank Clement (Bella), disqualified for cutting the course last year, made no such mistake as he carved his way through the field from 14th to 2nd just ahead of Graham Clark (SV). **Fastest:** Clement 27:04; Clark 27:25; W. Day (FVH) 27:32.

Stage 3: Lawrie Reilly made his first appearance in Scotland this season, lifting Victoria Park three places to the lead, 28 sec ahead of Southern, as he recorded the fastest lap of 18:35. Nigel Jones moved Edinburgh AC into contention for the first time, coming through from 7th to 3rd, while Spango Valley dropped

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Stage 4: John Graham started Clyde Valley off on the recovery trail, setting off 97 sec behind leaders, and catching all eight clubs in front of him with an inspired run which was 20 sec faster than the previous year's performance. Southern, thanks to a steady run by Evan Cameron, were second, 14 sec behind, with Jim Dingwall keeping Falkirk 3rd in front of Spango Valley. **Fastest:** Graham 26:42; W. Sheridan (W'lands) 27:20; Dingwall 27:23.

Stage 5: Jim Brown chose to run a short 3.7M stage because he was competing in a 10 mile race at Barrow the next day — and what a costly decision it was for his club! Though he clocked the fastest stage of 18:15 and opened up a 46 sec lead with just 1 lap to go, he would have been of much more value to Clyde Valley on a long stage of 5.8M. Falkirk stayed 3rd but Spango Valley continued their yo-yoing up and down the field, dropping to 6th. **Fastest:** Brown 18:15; A. Robertson (ESH) 18:47; D. Macgregor (Fife-V) 18:53.

Stage 6: Brian McSloy set off fast for Clyde Valley and actually added 8 sec to his large lead in the first mile, but he was no match for Allister Hutton (ESH) who closed the gap to 20 sec by half distance and swept remorselessly by the fading McSloy with just under a mile to the finish. Hutton's time was the fastest of the day by far but was still 15 sec outside his own course record. McSloy found his run was second fastest on the stage and, with most of the clubs having expended their big guns, Hamilton Cox's run of 28:17 brought Spango Valley through to 4th. **Fastest:** Hutton 26:16; McSloy 27:31; Cox 28:17.
